Trade in Value-Added in Asia and Russia

The analysis focuses on the global fragmentation of manufacturing industries in Asia and Russia. The newly developed “TiVA (Trade in Value-Added)” database is useful for the explanation of globalizing industries how they are interconnected across borders. TiVA database has been developed by OECD and WTO how to explain the inter-connectivity of international sourcing distinguished from the conventional trade statistics.

Specific manufacturing industries in Asia and Russia will be analyzed how to complete the final value across borders in terms of the International Input-Output Analysis using the TiVA database.
