Young Scientists Council of the Institute of Economics and Industrial Engineering invites you to take part in the XII Autumn Conference of young scientists in the Novosibirsk Academgorodok dedicated to 80 years of academician Alexander Granberg.

The Conference will take place in Academgorodok on October 10-13, 2016.

Within the program of this Conference it is planned to have reports of the leading scientists and the scientific youth of Russia and neighboring countries, to hold a round table dedicated to the discussion of ecological aspects of economic development, problems of rational management of nature, sociological school for economists.

All participants of the Young Scientists Conference can be present at the meetings of the International Conference “Spatial Analysis of the Social-Economic Systems: History and Modernity”, which will take place on the base of the Institute of Economics and Industrial Engineering at the same time.

To participate in the XII Autumn Young Scientists Conference, papers are accepted dedicated to the urgent problems of the contemporary economic and sociological science and methods of their solving. The thematic priorities are as follows:

- regional economy and territorial development;
- economics and management control of enterprises;
- economics of sectors and industrial complexes;
- economics of wildlife management;
- social-economic aspects of modern society development;
- innovations and innovative systems;
- general economic theory.

Participation in the conference is free of charge.

### **For participation in the Conference it is required:**

1. **Before 1<sup>st</sup> of September** to register at <http://ieie.su/conf/ysc2016.html> or to fill in the form with the information about yourself and theme of your report (Supplement 1) and then e-mail it to the address: [smu.conf@yandex.ru](mailto:smu.conf@yandex.ru)
2. **Before 1<sup>st</sup> of September** to attach the file with materials of your report while registering or to send it separately to the address [smu.conf@yandex.ru](mailto:smu.conf@yandex.ru) Paper covering the main contents

of your report should be formed up in accordance with the rules described in Supplement 2. It should contain scientific and practical results obtained by the author.

3. **Before 15<sup>th</sup> of September**, in accordance with the results of the expert commission work, all the registered participants will be informed about acceptance or rejection of their reports by the addresses notified in the applications.

All received papers will pass through preliminary reviewing. When the Conference Program is formed, invitations will be sent to the participants.

Before the opening of the conference, all the received materials, which are included in the conference program, will be posted at the web-page of the conference.

Publication of the proceedings is planned after the conference. Please, pay attention that publication of your paper in the Proceedings Volume will be possible only in case of your presentation at the conference (face-to-face or online in the format of video-conference).

The best reports can be recommended for publishing in one of the three peer-reviewed journals which are in the list of the Higher Attestation Commission of Russia (EKO; Region: Economics and Sociology; Bulletin of the Novosibirsk State University).

Time limit for presenting a paper at the conference is 10 minutes. After each presentation there will be discussion of paper during 10 minutes.

The working language of the Conference: Russian and English.

## Supplement 2.

### **Rules for Drawing Up Articles**

**Volume of an article should be 5-6 pages, format A5.**

Text editor Microsoft Word, type font Times New Roman, size 10.

Line spacing is single. Text adjustment is by page width. Shift of red line is 5 mm. All margins should be 2 cm.

Author's last name and initials should be printed in capital letters on the first page, center aligned. Follow place of work or study (institution, city). Follow article title in capital letters.

**Small summary of an article in Russian and in English (4-5 sentences) is a must, author's translation of an article's title in English, key words in Russian and in English. Summary and key words in Russian and in English should be before body of an article, after author credentials and title.**

You are recommended to use built-in experience of Microsoft Word, Equation or MathType, to type formulas. All formulas should be typed in Latin letters (at least, in Russian letters) but not in words.

**Drawings and graphics** should have distinct appearance and be black-white (volume of proceedings will be in black and white). You have to insert drawings and graphics in the article and **send them additionally by separate file.**

Heads of tables should not be toned and not bold printed. Some cells of tables could be highlighted in gray or black but only if this coloring has a special meaning.

Bibliography references should be in square brackets (for example, [2, p.64]). List of references should be at the end of article. Each author has to spell check his/her article. Material submitted to the conference is not reviewed, and is published in author's edition.

*Organizing committee reserves the right to reject articles if: 1) they are prepared with inadequacy in regards to the mentioned rules; 2) submitted after the deadline.*
