The Council of Young Scientists of the Institute of Economics and Industrial Engineering of the Siberian Branch of the Russian Academy of Sciences and the Faculty of Economics of Novosibirsk State University (NSU) invites you to take part in the **XV Autumn Conference of Young Scientists in the Novosibirsk Academgorodok: Current Issues of Economics and Sociology**, which will be held from *November 18 to 20, 2019*.

The purpose of the conference is to create conditions and the opportunity for young scientists and students to present the results of their research work, to receive expert evaluation, recommendations for further scientific research from leading scientists of the IEIE of the SB RAS and the economic faculty of NSU.

Within the program of the Conference, it is planned to observe reports of leading scientists and scientific youth of Russia and neighboring countries, to hold a round table "Desk Books of a Modern Economist and Sociologist", business games, debates and master classes.

To participate in the "XV Autumn Conference of Young Scientists in the Novosibirsk Academgorodok: Current Issues of Economics and Sociology" reports on the following main areas are accepted:

- regional economy and territorial development;
- public administration (with the support of RFTA SOPS and Institute of Industrial Markets and Infrastructure of the RANEPA);
- finance and regional investment processes (with the support of IE UB RAS);
- political and demographic trends in the sociological dimension: institutions, structures and processes;
- economics and enterprise management;
- resource and environmental economics;
- economic integration in the Asia-Pacific region (with the support of ERI FEB RAS);
- innovations and innovation systems;
- economics of digital society: theory and practice (with the support of IE UB RAS);
- sociological studies of technological and socio-economic trends in modern society;
- usage of the "input-output" methodology in applied economic research (with the support of Institute of Economic Forecasting RAS).

Full-time and distance (with the presentation of a poster report) participation is possible in the Conference.

For participation in the Conference it is required to fill in the application form (see Appendix 1) and send it along with the report materials to *smu.conf@yandex.ru* before October 15. Registration of materials is carried out in accordance with the rules specified in Appendix 2. The Organizing Committee reserves the right not to consider applications that are prepared without taking in account the rules of registration.

If within 7 days after registration / submission of materials you do not receive confirmation of getting the application / materials to the address notified in the applications, we recommend contacting the organizing committee with this question at the address smu.conf@yandex.ru.

Please note that all submitted materials are checked for plagiarism (originality not less than 65%), as well as pass through a preliminary review.

By November 1, according to the results of expert selection, registered participants are notified of the acceptance or rejection of their reports at the email addresses indicated in the applications.

Materials accepted for participation in the Conference will be posted on the Conference website *http://ieie.su/conf/ysc2019* before its commencement.

The publication of conference materials with article-by-article indexation in the RSCI (example: a collection of 2018 - https://elibrary.ru/item.asp?id=36509885) is planned after the event.

According to the results of expert assessment, the materials received can be recommended for publication in one of four refereed journals included in the Russian HAC list (ECO; Region: Economics and Sociology; World of Economics and Management; Journal of Economic Theory) provided their inperson presentation at the Conference.

There will be a competition of reports among students and undergraduates. The laureates of competition will receive memorable prizes and certificates.

Accommodation for non-resident participants is expected at the Golden Valley Hotel, located within walking distance from the venue of the event. Conference participants have priority and in some cases a right for a special (preferential) price list. For more information on accommodation contact the organizing committee at *smu.conf@yandex.ru*. To form a common guest list, it is necessary to inform the Organizing Committee of the arrival and departure dates 5-7 days prior to the Conference, the desired room category.

All expenses on travel, food, accommodation are carried out by sending organization or by participant personally.

Time limit for speeches:

The total time for the presentation of the report at the conference is 15 minutes. After each presentation, the discussion of the report takes 5-7 minutes.

All participants are given the opportunity to present their results in the refereed sections of the Conference. At the sessions of the discussion sections, after the presentation of the report, the floor is given to the discussion person, who within 5-7 minutes gives a brief assessment of the work and asks the first questions about the work.

The working language of the conference - Russian, English.

Terms of registration materials

The volume of materials - 8-12 thousand characters with spaces, taking into account all the elements (information about the authors, names, annotations, keywords, tables and figures, references).

Text editor - Microsoft Word, A5 page format, Times New Roman font, font size - 10 pt. Line spacing - single. Text align - the width of the page. No transfers. Red space indents - 5 mm. All fields - 2 cm.

The first line indicates the JEL index, left text alignment.

Then typed in capital letters (Caps lock) letters of the names and initials of the authors, the alignment on the center of the page. On the next line - a place of work or study (institution, city). Next is the title of the article in capital letters. The title of the scientific report should be brief and informative, accurately corresponding to its content and be problematic.

The obligatory requirement is the presence of a small summary (4-5 sentences) and keywords (up to 6). The summary should not be an introduction to your topic. The summary should contain the justification of the choice of topic, a description of the chosen research methodology, the main results and conclusions of the work.

After specifying keywords in Russian, the translation of information about the author, title of work, resume and keywords into English is posted.

The text of the report is printed after one empty line. Materials submitted for consideration should have the structure of a full-fledged scientific publication and include an introductory word about the research topic and its relevance; the purpose and objectives of scientific research; a review of the literature in the field of research, a description of the research methodology, an information base / data sources for conducting the research, main results and conclusions. The article should clearly show the personal contribution of the author to the relevant area of knowledge (originality of the work, scientific / practical result).

To create formulas use the built-in capabilities of Microsoft Word: Equation or MathType. All formulas should be written in Latin (in extreme cases, Russian) letters of the alphabet, and not in words.

Drawings and graphics should have a clear image. Drawings and graphics should be inserted into the text of the article and additionally sent as a separate file.

Tables and figures should have headings. The name and numbers of the figures are indicated below the figures, in the center.

The names and numbers of the tables are above the tables on the left. Tables, diagrams, figures, formulas, graphs should not go beyond the page (on the field).

Table caps do not tint, do not print in bold. Separate cells of the tables can be highlighted in gray or black only if the tone carries any meaning.

Bibliographic references are in square brackets (for example, [2, p.64]). The list of references is to be located at the end of the article. The text should be carefully verified by the author (be sure to check the article for spelling and grammar).

Presented materials will be published in the author's edition.
